## GSSE Funding Opportunities

### Organization of American States Scholarship

- Award Amount:** \$50,000, to be applied to the total cost of the three-semester program.
- Deadline:** March 31, 2018
- About the Award:** The Organization of American States (OAS), through the Department of Human Development, Education and Employment and Colorado State University, through the OAS Partnerships Program for Education and Training, are offering scholarships to qualified candidates of the Americas.
- Qualifications:** You must be accepted into the GSSE MBA program to be considered for this scholarship, and you must maintain good academic standing (3.0 or higher) in order to keep the award. You also must be a citizen and/or permanent legal resident of any OAS member state, except the United States of America.
- To Apply:** You apply for this scholarship after you have been admitted to GSSE.

### Matthew Hammerdorfer Memorial Scholarship

- Award Amount:** \$3,000, to be applied to the total cost of the three-semester program.
- Deadline:** Due by the early application deadline for admission into GSSE.
- About the Award:** This scholarship was established to honor the life and the love of Matthew Hammerdorfer, the son of GSSE's first director, Carl Hammerdorfer. Matthew intended to follow in the footsteps of his parents and join the Peace Corps. He truly lived the phrase "carpe diem" by embracing opportunities, dreaming big and being a kind and caring individual. He looked forward to continued travels, especially to Africa.
- Qualifications:** You must be a citizen of a country within the African continent, and be accepted into the GSSE MBA program to be considered for a scholarship. You must maintain good academic standing (3.0 or higher) in order to keep the award.
- To Apply:** You must complete the application found at this site: CSU Scholarship Applications (CSUSA). The CSUSA will be available online on your RAMweb beginning Dec. 1.

## GSSE Impact, Sustainability, and International Scholarship

- Award Amount:** \$15,000 Impact Scholarship, to be applied to the total cost of the three-semester program.  
\$9,000 Sustainability Scholarship, to be applied to the total cost of the three-semester program.  
Up to \$60,000 International Scholarship, to be applied to the total cost of the three-semester program.
- Deadline:** Feb. 1 priority deadline  
May 1 final deadline  
Applications received by the early priority deadline will be given preference.
- About the Award:** As funding allows, the GSSE Scholarship Committee awards one or more of these scholarships based on the merit of the applicant.
- Qualifications:** You must be accepted into the GSSE MBA program to be considered for a scholarship. You must maintain good academic standing (3.0 or higher) in order to keep the award.
- To Apply:** Submit a link to a 2-3 minute video of yourself addressing the following: 1) Your name and background. 2) An accomplishment that you felt had a positive impact. ## Peace Corps Coverdell Fellowship

- Award Amount:** For out-of-state: \$38,000\*  
For in-state: \$16,150\*  
These amounts include a scholarship, assistantship stipend, health insurance premium, and the application fee.
- Deadline:** Feb. 1 priority deadline  
Applications received by the early priority deadline will be given preference.
- About the Award:** The Peace Corps Coverdell Fellowship includes a discount to in-state tuition rates (if applicable) plus a graduate assistantship. Read more information about the [assistantship requirements](#). In the third semester, there is an internship requirement as well.
- Qualifications:** The GSSE Scholarship Committee awards up to two of these fellowships based on the merit of the applicant. You must be accepted into the GSSE MBA program to be considered for the award. You must maintain good academic standing (3.0 or higher) in order to keep the award.
- To Apply:** Please indicate in your resume on your application to GSSE that you were a Peace Corps Volunteer, and complete the application for a [Graduate Assistantship](#). Please note that the information provided in the assistantship application will be used for matching you to a professor or unit, but the award decision will be based on your application to GSSE.
