Presentation: The HR in THoR: Cinematic Lessons of High-Performance Work

Practices Across the Globe

Decisions about the design, delivery, and integration of Human Resource practices are both important and challenging. This challenge grows when an organization operates globally. Using movies as metaphors, we will jointly consider research on High Performance Work Practices (HPWP) and share reflections on how they match your global experiences. This research defines best practices in the areas of compensation, staffing, performance management, training and development and other HR areas from within a global context. We'll also view a valid measure for HPWP and see which practices have the highest relationship with market, operational, and financial performance. We will also consider together how the best practice depends upon the organization's strategic focus as well as the results that show that practices that lead to high performance in Anglo cultures may not be effective in Asian cultures and vice versa. Finally, we will integrate our discussion with research on humble leadership and evidence-based cultures to determine implications for HR executive leadership in global organizations.
